The funds set up for this scholarship program will initially provide up to three \$500 awards per year. The Board of Directors intends to grow this fund's capacity and fulfill its obligation to honor the Adams Family's gracious generosity to our charitable organizations' commitment to volunteerism and educational excellence.

Eligibility Requirements:

An applicant must complete the following:

1. Complete the application form.
2. Provide evidence of admission to an accredited college, university, trade school, apprenticeship, or certificate program.
3. Provide a copy of your latest official transcripts (High School transcripts if the student has yet to attend yet to attend a higher level of education).
4. Provide a letter of recommendation from one of the following: teacher, advisor, veteran, or government representative and or civic leader.
5. An educational commitment essay describes your educational goals and what patriotism means to them.
6. Abide by rules and regulations set forth by the CCCA, Inc. Scholarship Program.
7. Agree to waiver to utilize personal pictures and related information that describes the scholarship award's intent.
8. Agree to a follow-up interview on the success of the educational and personal excellence achieved to be shared with the CCCA, Inc. membership and social media platforms.

This scholarship packet will be scored on a 100-point scale with a possible extra 40 points. The packet will be graded as follows:

A maximum of 140 awarded points is possible. The final decision on awardees will be by the CCCA, Adams Family Scholarship Program Policy.

20 Points – Letter of Recommendation

40 Points – Education Excellence and Patriotism Essay
